




Five Core Discipleship Values


Building a faith-filled community, fostering love for God and others and equipping believers to live out the Great Commission across diverse cultures.











Authentic Relationships: The core of our faith and life is to love God and love others. Everyone committed to the Great Commission should be engaged in relationships that honor God and edify the Body of Christ. Loving relationships help us walk the path of holiness as we receive both encouragement and loving correction.


Comprehensive Biblical Learning: Learning Scriptures, through individual and group study, helps disciples to become more like Christ. When we study the Word of God, which is active and living, we uncover who God is, how God loves and how we are also to love others.

Fervent Prayer: Prayer is an essential part of discipleship. It is the bedrock upon which all other ministry efforts are build. As we pray, God inspires us to be actively engaged in the world. Through prayer, we participate in the Holy Spirit's transforming power, both for ourselves and for our

Intentional Mentoring & Equipping: Mentoring and equipping is a discipleship process that introduces new believers to Jesus and reveals how to follow Him personally and fully. Mentoring and equipping others on the journey of discipleship is essential to Christian growth and maturity.

Compassionate Outreach: God is continually reaching out to prepare people's hearts to receive salvation. Compassionate outreach reveals God's love for humanity. It is a disciple's care for non-believers, both local and global that places a face and hand to God's grace and love.

NWIL Children's Bible Quizzing Report – 2024-2025

Here is a summary of our quizzes and activities.

The 2024-2025 Children's Bible Quizzing year went very well. Our goal is to use the Quizzing Curriculum to study the Word of God with our quizzers. We studied the book of Matthew in 2023-2024 and the book of Acts in 2024-2025. Seven churches with 17-20 children were consistently involved in the Area and District Quizzes. We had our district quiz on April 13, 2024, at Eureka Grace church, two Area Quizzes at North Pekin (11/16/24 and Pekin (2/15/25) and the new District Quiz will be held in Lewistown on April 12, 2025. There were 13 who memorized either 10 or 20 verses and received trophies at the April 2024 quiz.

The NWIL District sent a 5 member All Star Team from each level to the Regional Quiz at ONU and one additional quizzer participated. One of our Red Level quizzers won a top ten trophy. We were so proud of our children this year.


Peace Out












YOUNG ADULT MINISTRY


